# East Link Connections Project

## New Route 202

### Neighborhoods Served:

- Bellevue Transit Center, Woodridge, Eastgate Park and Ride, Issaquah Transit Center, Issaquah Highlands Transit Center

### Summary of Proposed Changes:

- New route providing local connections between downtown Bellevue and Issaquah’s transit centers
- Provides new service to neighborhoods north of I-90 between North Issaquah and Eastgate.

### Why is this change being proposed?

- Provides new local connections between Eastgate and Issaquah
- Provides improved connection to Link in Woodridge neighborhood

### How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1?

- Provides more local neighborhood connections to transfer to Link light rail.

- \* Frequent - The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.
- \* Local - All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.
- \* Peak-only - The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
