Neighborhoods Served:

- Eastgate Park and Ride, Somerset, Factoria, Bellevue

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Moves service from 146th Ave SE and SE Allen Rd to SE 36th St, 150th Ave SE, 148th Ave SE, Highland Dr, and Somerset Blvd SE
- New Route 203 on Newport Way provides an alternative for Allen Rd riders.

Why is this change being proposed?

- Replaces Route 246 service in Somerset

How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1?

- More transfer opportunities so riders can travel to different local and regional destinations

*Frequent- The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.

*Local- All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

*Peak-only – The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
