

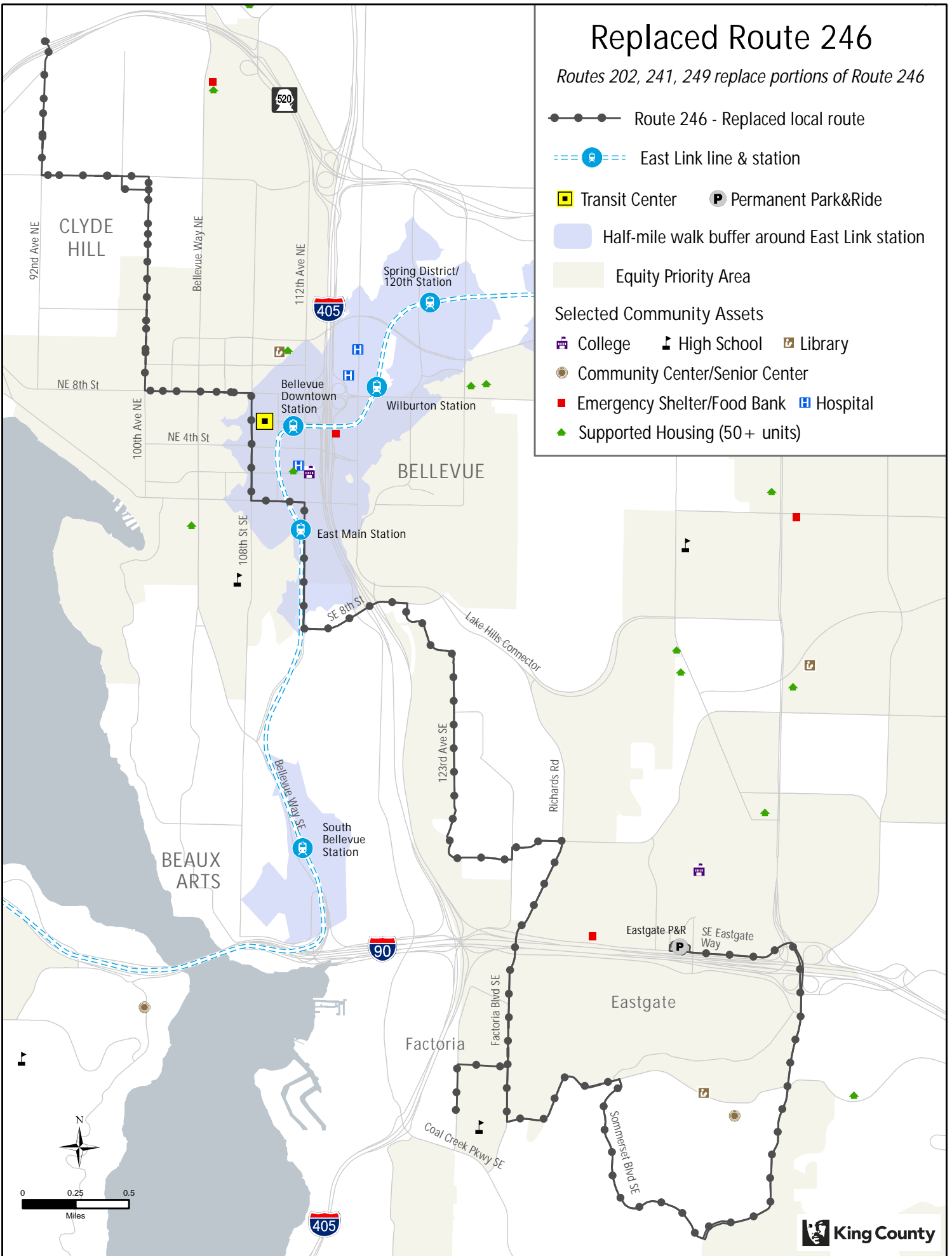
Replaced Route 246

Replaced Route 246

Neighborhoods Served:

- Eastgate Park and Ride, Somerset, Factoria, Woodridge, Bellevue, Clyde Hill

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Revised Route 241 replaces the portion of the Route 246 from Eastgate Park and Ride, through Somerset and Factoria
- New Route 202 replaces the portion of the Route 246 from downtown Bellevue through the Woodridge neighborhood to SE 26th St and Richards Rd
- Revised Route 249 replaces the portion in Clyde Hill

Why is this change being proposed?

- To improve connections, and speed up travel times
- To connect local neighborhoods to Link light rail
