

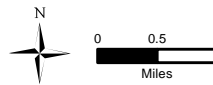

Neighborhoods Served:

- Bear Creek Park and Ride, Redmond, Overlake, Yarrow Point/Clyde Hill, Evergreen Point, Downtown Seattle

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Revised ST Express 542 replaces the portion of Route 268 from Bear Creek Park and Ride to Redmond
- Revised Route 269 replaces the portion of Route 268 on NE Redmond Way, and 180th Ave NE

Why is this change being proposed?

- To provide additional service to connect SE Redmond to Link light rail stations
- Because Route 268 is duplicative of Link light rail connections
