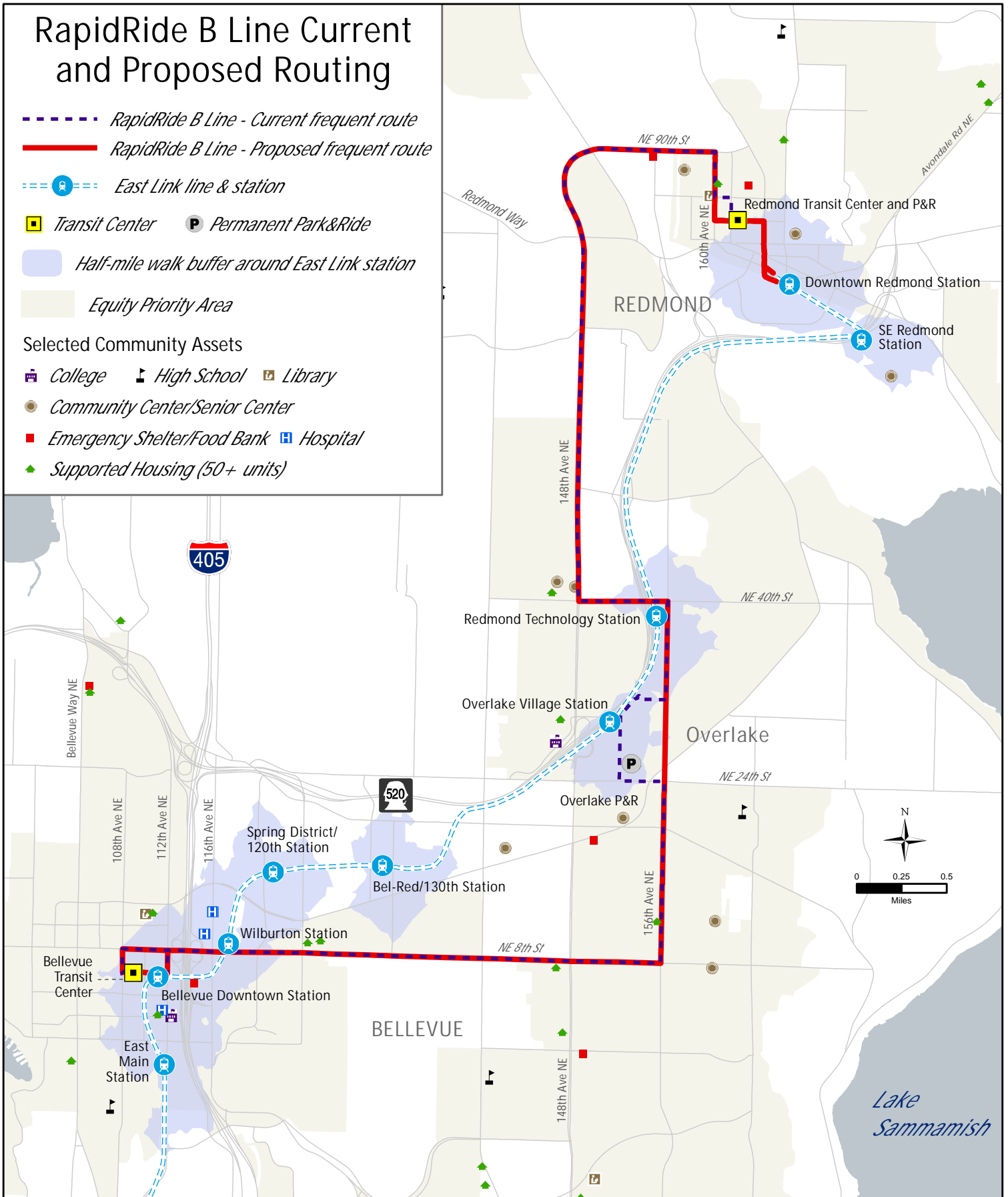


RapidRide B Line Current and Proposed Routing

Revised RapidRide B Line

Neighborhoods Served:

- Downtown Redmond Link Station, Redmond Transit Center, Overlake, Crossroads, downtown Bellevue

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Extend service from Redmond Transit Center to Downtown Redmond Link Station via 164th Ave NE
- Move service to 156th Ave NE between NE 24th St and NE 31st St. Revised Route 245 now services 152nd Ave NE on this segment.

Why is this change being proposed?

- To extend the route to Downtown Redmond Link Station
- Improve speed and reliability for the route between downtown Redmond and Crossroads

How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1?

- More transfer opportunities so riders can travel to different local and regional destinations

- Speed and reliability, with more direct paths on faster routes where possible

*Frequent - The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.

*Local - All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

*Peak-only - The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
