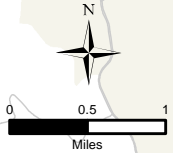

## East Link Connections Project

### Replaced Route 212

#### Neighborhoods Served:

- Eastgate Park and Ride, Downtown Seattle

#### Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Revised routes 215, 269 and 218 replace the portion of the Route 212 between Eastgate and Mercer Island
- Link light rail replaces the portion of the Route 212 between Mercer Island Station and downtown Seattle

#### Why is this change being proposed?

- To create a more reliable connection between downtown Seattle, Mercer Island, Issaquah, and other eastside destinations
