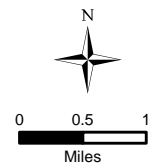

Replaced Route 219

Neighborhoods Served:

- SE Redmond, Sammamish, Issaquah Highlands Park and Ride, Eastgate, Mercer Island, downtown Seattle

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Revised Route 269 replaces Route 219 between SE Redmond and Mercer Island
- Link light rail replaces Route 219 between Mercer Island Station and downtown Seattle

Why is this change being proposed?

- To create a more reliable connection between downtown Seattle, Mercer Island, Issaquah, and other eastside destinations
