Neighborhoods Served:

- Woodinville, Redmond

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- New route beginning at Woodinville Park and Ride, NE 178th St to NE Mill Pl turning left onto Garden Way NE, right onto NE 175th St, left onto Woodinville-Redmond Rd NE and continuing to downtown Redmond

Why is this change being proposed?

- To create a new, fast connections between Woodinville and Redmond with transfers to Link light rail

How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1?

- Improve and add local connections
- More service on nights and weekends
- Ensure transfers are easy and seamless

* Frequent - The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.

* Local – All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

* Peak-only – The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
