Revised Route 931

Neighborhoods Served:

- UW/Cascadia Bothell, Woodinville, Cottage Lake, Duvall

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- New connection from downtown Duvall to Cottage Lake via NE Woodinville Duvall Rd
- The portion of Route 931 on Avondale Rd NE from NE Woodinville Duvall Rd to NE 128th Way is replaced by new Route 222
- The portion of Route 931 on 156th Ave NE from NE 124th Way to downtown Redmond is replaced by new Route 251

Why is this change being proposed?

- To create a direct, east-west connection between Bothell, Woodinville and Duvall

How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1?

- Improve and add local connections

*Frequent- The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.

*Local- All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

*Peak-only – The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
