- Renton, Kenndale, Newport Hills, Clyde Hill, University District

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Between Renton and New Port Hills Park and Ride Route 167 is replaced by revised Route 342
- Riders destined for the University District can connect to new Route 270 and Link in downtown Bellevue

Why is this change being proposed?

- To provide additional service throughout the day, night, and on weekends
- To provide travel inbound and outbound during all hours in service
