Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Service moved from SE Eastgate Way to SE 36th St between Factoria Blvd SE and Eastgate Park and Ride
- New pathway between Eastgate Park & Ride and Bellevue Transit Center via SE Eastgate Way, 148th Ave SE, Bellevue College, 145th Pl SE, Lake Hills Connector, 116th Ave NE, NE 4th St
- Provides coverage for portions of replaced Route 114, which is combined with revised Route 111

Why is this change being proposed?

- To provide connections to community assets in Factoria and Bellevue

How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1?

- Improves connections between Renton Highlands and Bellevue
- Ensures connections to hospitals and other community assets

- Provides connections to Link light rail

* Frequent - The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.

* Local - All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

* Peak-only - The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
