# Replaced Peak-Only Route 219 - Phase 3

#### **Neighborhoods Served:**

 SE Redmond, Sammamish, Issaquah Highlands Park and Ride, Eastgate, Mercer Island, downtown Seattle

## **Summary of Proposed Changes:**

- Revised Route 269 replaces Route 219 between SE Redmond and Mercer Island.
- Link light rail replaces Route 219 between Mercer Island Station and downtown Seattle.

### Why is this change being proposed?

• To create a more reliable connection between downtown Seattle, Mercer Island, Issaquah, Sammamish, and other eastside destinations.

# How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1 and 2?

- High frequency at traditional peak commute hours.
- Improves connections to transit hubs.
- No changes being proposed from Phase 2.

<sup>\*</sup> Frequent - The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.

<sup>\*</sup>Local – All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

 $^{*}$  Peak-only – The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
