Replaced Peak-Only Route 237- Phase 3

Neighborhoods Served:

- Woodinville, Brickyard Park and Ride, Totem Lake Freeway Station, Houghton, Bellevue

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- New Route 256 replaces the portion of Route 237 between Woodinville and Totem Lake Freeway Station.
- The deletion of Route 237 will occur in 2023.

Why is this change being proposed?

- To provide a new connection to South Lake Union.

How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1?

- Preserve easy access to downtown Seattle.

* Frequent - The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.

* Local - All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

* Peak-only - The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
