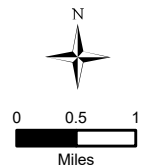


Phase 3: Route 111 Current and Proposed

East Link Connections Project

Revised Local Route 111 – Phase 3

Neighborhoods Served:

- Lake Kathleen, Renton Highlands, Kenndale, Newport, Bellevue

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Reorient route to end at South Bellevue Link Station.
- Increase service to operate all-day, all week.
- Shorten Lake Kathleen loop by no longer serving low ridership stops.
- In the Renton Highlands, Route 111 serves Harrington Ave NE and NE 12th St between Edmonds Ave NE and Sunset Blvd NE.
- This change will occur in 2023.

Why is this change being proposed?

- Connect bus routes to Link light rail stations.
- Provide more all-day, all-week service.
- More efficiently serve current destinations as well as planned development in Renton Highlands.

How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1 and 2?

- More service outside of peak periods. Weekday hours of service expanded in the evening based on Phase 2 feedback.
- Improves connections to transit hubs.
- Provides connections to Link light rail stations.
- Improves connections between Renton Highlands and Bellevue.

* Frequent - The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.

* Local - All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

* Peak-only - The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
